

# FCAEF Flight Program



**BIRTHING A PILOT: 9-MONTH FLIGHT PROGRAM** uses a combination of FAA approved flight curriculum to facilitate the broad age range of our students. In addition to the flight instruction, we use games and reward programs as learning incentives for each student in our program.

Classes commence every Saturday, alternating between on-site (airport) and zoom. On-site class time is 11a - 2p (or until flights are complete). Zoom class is from 11a - 12p (Ground Instruction only) We encourage full participation by using pop quizzes to assess learning potential and information retention.

Upon enrollment students receive a pilot kit including: Logbook, Binder, Photo ID, Syllabus/ Literature (paper and electronic), Flight Computer, Covid Kit. Additional supplies are part of our reward program which includes additional flight time, aviator gifts and apparel.

Enrollment requirements include quarterly report cards. We have no anticipated GPA expectation, but progress is monitored, and resources will be offered to help when needed. While attendance and program progress may be considered in current enrollment status once enrolled, our enrollment is first come, first serve.

Once students turn 15 years of age, they will graduate to a more accelerated program within the 9-MONTH FLIGHT PROGRAM which allots each student, over 15 years of age, an extra 2 hours of ground and flying time.

Students 15 and up will also be given their Part 1 and Part 2 Syllabus among other resources to continue to pursue their career in aviation. Students will continue to go to the Saturday group sessions, but will have private lessons with a certified flight instructor at scheduled times.

Our overall goal is to encourage all students to acquire a solo and complete their private pilot written by the age of 16 years old.

FCAEF is also developing programs that will be made available to all students in our program, once development is complete. These programs include but are not limited to the following: Mechanic Program, Drone Training, Tutoring Program, Music Creative Studio Program, Basketball League, Etiquette Class, Creative Arts Program, and Financial Literacy.

In addition to Saturday lessons, FCAEF also incorporates the following into calendar of events: Birthday Club, Mentor Speaking, Community Clean Up, Museum Visits/Field Trips. FCAEF standing annual events: Annual Air Fair and Aviation Day.
